Traffic Safety

Now that we are back in school, it is time for a reminder about our traffic safety practices. We need EVERYONE to follow our procedures in order to have a smooth arrival and dismissal. If everyone follows these rules, everyone benefits and ALL children remain safe. We appreciate your support and partnership to ensure safety and a calm arrival and dismissal.

Parking Lot Rules

- The entrance to the parking lot is on Prairie Dunes Way. The driveway on Wildhawk West is an exit only and **RIGHT TURN ONLY** during drop off and dismissal times.
- When dropping off your children, you will need to wait your turn in the drive through line until you have reached the 'meet and greet' area (between the orange cones) where a staff member will assist your child getting in and out of your car.
- You may not drop off your child from the left hand lane of the drive through line.
- If you choose to park your car in the parking lot, you must park your car in a designated parking spot and walk your child to the gate by the flagpole. Under no circumstances is a child to walk unattended in the parking lot.
- At no time should you double park in the parking lot, block cars in parking spaces or use the handicap parking space (if you do not have a handicapped sticker plate).
- Please do not load or unload in the parking lot unless you are parked in a designated parking space and you are with your child.
- Please **NO U-TURNS...NO U-TURNS** anywhere near the school during drop-off and dismissal
- **BE PATIENT!** All students and cars are off campus within 15 minutes.
- Only cross at painted crosswalks. Do not cross through traffic!

Please DO NOT make U-TURNS in this section of WILDHAWK WEST it impedes the flow of traffic



Please follow the direction of staff on duty....they are there for your children's safety.

Please do not use your cell phone while driving near school....it's the law!



Please do not make U-Turns ANYWHERE on Wildhawk West Drive during drop off and dismissal. This drastically impacts traffic flow and safety!



You must have the appropriate license plate to park in these spaces. AND please park in ONLY designated parking spots.



Please teach your children traffic safety practices by using only crosswalks to cross the street. What we model for them is what they will do when we are not with them. Help keep our students safe!!
